Reference Services

 We offer literature searches on request, supplying appropriate citations and abstracts from PubMed/Medline and other sources. Delivery of results normally takes 2-3 working days (depending on the extent of the Research). Just email your request (with as much detail as possible).

One Click... Just Ask! Evidence-Based Resource Search Engine

• The Library's catalog and online resources are all accessed on the Library's ON CAMPUS website by visiting **NatividadLibrary.com**... you can search most of our evidence-based resources through our One Click... Just! Search engine located on the top of each Library webpage and on RISE. Many of our resources are Full Text. If you cannot get to Full Text access, you will be directed to an easy to complete ILL form which will then be processed and the article will be emailed to you.

Online on Campus

- The Medical Library's resources are mainly available ON CAMPUS only (see below for access OFF CAMPUS) through RISE and through the Library's website. Visit NatividadLibrary.com. Or Click Internet browser icon which will default to RISE, and then either use the Search the Medical Library search box or Click Quick Links and select Library. These are also available on your mobile devices at NatividadLibrary.com when you are on NatividadGuest WiFi.
- Also, the Library's resources are available through MediTech. **Click** on the Library's icon.

Online off Campus

- Providers can use VPN Access via Horizon Client through which you can either **Click** on the Library's icon or use Remote Desktop and **Click** on Internet browser icon. You will have full access as if you were ON CAMPUS.
- You can also visit **<u>NatividadLibrary.com</u>** and **<u>Click</u>** on the blue button Mobile Access for instructions. You can search all of the Library's resources, but most Full-Text and databases will not be available; you will be prompted to request the item via ILL. Feel free to do so.
